

# Exercises: HTML Basics, Part 1

1. Make a page with these capabilities:

- A main heading
- Some subheadings
- Some paragraphs
- An image that floats to the right of the page with text wrapping around it. Note that images found on [images.google.com](http://images.google.com) are often not legal for use on your own pages. However, there are many free image sites, one of which is [pixabay.com](http://pixabay.com).
- A bulleted list
- A numbered list
- A navigation panel with hypertext links to the top of the current page, bottom of the current page, top of a second page, and bottom of a second page. For the second page, just copy the first page and change the title.

Here is a representative example, although if you do not know about CSS yet, do not worry about reproducing the page background color or the color and background of the main heading.
