

Composite Components 2: Input Components

- 1.** Make a composite component to collect a physical street address. Assume that an address consists of a state, city, street number, and postal code. For now, don't bother to make component attributes for the prompts (e.g., "State:") or requiredMessage (e.g. "Mandatory!"), but just hardcode them into the component.
- 2.** Make a page that collects a person's name and address. Make a results page that shows the information.
- 3.** Add a CSS file so that the prompts for the state, city, address, and postal code are right-aligned. For the actual alignment, you can steal the "formTable" entry from the CSS file of composite-components-2, but you need to figure out where to put the CSS file and how to refer to it from your component.
- 4.** Make the prompts (e.g., "State:") and requiredMessage (e.g. "Mandatory!") be changeable by the page author, instead of hardcoding them into the component.
