

Exercises: PrimeFaces Menus

Make a new PrimeFaces project and give it a menu bar. Be sure the menu bar is inside an h:form.

- 1.** Make a menu called “Search” that has entries for a few search engines (Google, Bing, etc.) When the user clicks on the menu entry, they should see the home page of the associated search site.
- 2.** Make a menu called “Sites” that contains three submenus: “Search” (with the same entries as #1 above), “Social Networking” (Facebook, LinkedIn), and “Travel” (Travelocity, Orbitz, Expedia, Kayak). As in the last problem, when the user clicks on the menu entry, they should see the home page of the associated site.
- 3.** Make a menu called “Actions” that has two entries. When the user clicks on the first entry, a simple dialog box containing static content should appear. When the user clicks on the second entry, a dialog box should appear that shows the current date/time. This time should be updated every time the dialog box is opened.
